## GATED YARD FOR AFTER HOURS

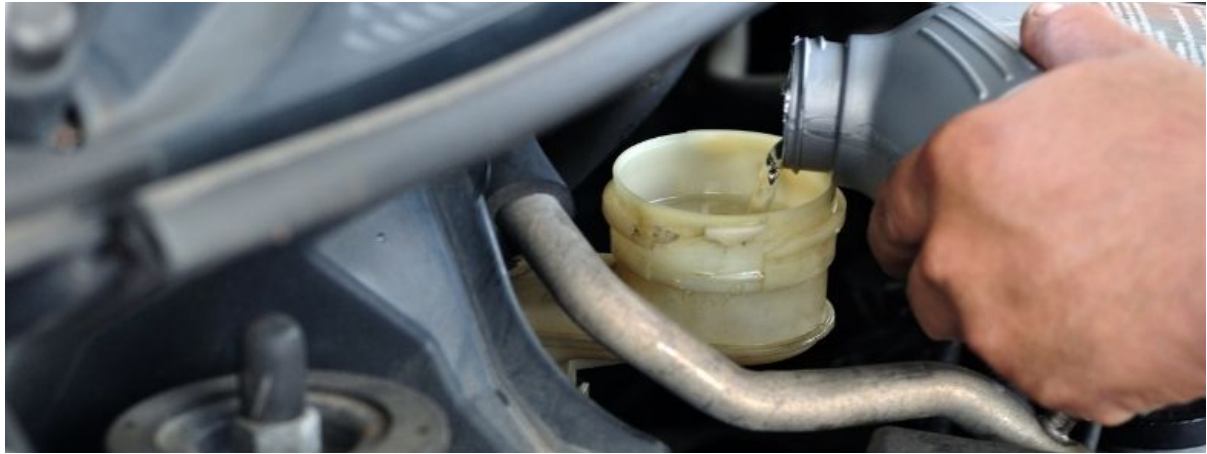

## HOW TO KEEP YOUR CAR BATTERY HEALTHY

You don't have to be mechanically minded to keep your car battery healthy. While they don't last forever, and factors like battery type, age, use, frequency of service and weather can affect how long it lasts, it's easy to look after and help extend the life of your car's battery.

Here are some simple steps you can take to help keep your car battery in tip top shape:

### **Drive your car!**

Your car is designed for driving, and one key factor for a healthy battery is that you drive it. Yes, driving your car helps keep the car battery healthy. The battery charges as you drive and the battery will be its happiest the closer it is to a full charge.

### **Check your lights before you walk away**

When you've parked and locked your car double check that you haven't left any interior or exterior lights on, especially push on interior lights that you may have knocked with your hands when getting something out of the car. If a light is left on, it'll start to drain your battery and if this happens frequently it'll start to impact the health of the battery.

## **Avoid leaving your car unused for long periods**

If you won't be using your car or you're going on a long holiday, i.e. longer than a month, consider connecting a maintenance or trickle charger to the battery. This will help prevent self-discharge and ensure the battery remains charged.

## **Check how long it's been under the hood**

On average, most batteries are designed to last at least 2 to 3 years, and beyond that, they will eventually lose the ability to hold full charge, and over longer term, you'll start to notice issues. So, if the battery has been used for over 3 years and your car is becoming more and more sluggish to start, chat with your mechanic (before you get stuck somewhere with a flat battery!).

## **Keep it clean**

Keep the top of the battery clean and dry and remove any build up. Battery terminals corrode over time, so removing any build up will help. To do this you could scrub the terminals using water and a small firm brush and then dry using a clean cloth. While you're keeping it clean, check the battery for any bulging, cracking or leaking. If you notice any of these signs of wear, it's time for a new battery.

## **Get your car serviced regularly**

Keep your car's engine in tip top shape by getting it serviced regularly. Bad engine condition can place even more demand on the battery, impacting its performance and health.
